



Lake Tswei

Lake Tswei is one of the largest artificial lake, covering an area of 8,000 square meters, in Taipei City. The facilities on which include a Shang Shan Bridge and a Tsuei Heng Pagoda. Along the lakeside the branches and leaves are luxuriant, with cascading willows swaying along the breezes. There are two large-scale lotus containers and three ecological floating islands in the lake, adding to a blossoming landscape on the Lake Tswei, especial in the night.



NATIONAL DR.SUN YAT-SEN MEMORIAL HALL (ENGLISH)



Chung Shan Park

The Memorial Hall which located in the Eastern District of Taipei City, covers construction and Chungshan Park that includes cement square and greenbelt, total area of 11 hectares. The Chungshan Park is designed as the axis of center flag-raising, fountain and the building itself, yet symmetrically on the both sides. The configuration of main plant is also cultivated symmetrically. Fountain composes by vertical, fan nozzle and driving motors which performance all styles of water spray, and circulate every 14 minutes. It is more popular by visitors for the night scene of fountain lighting.

The Short History of National Dr. Sun Yat-sen Memorial Hall

For commemorating founding father, Dr. Sun Yat-sen, a great man with wisdom, benevolence, and courage and his great revolutionary career, furthermore with the function of cultural and educational activities and academic research, it was in 1964 that the proposal of setting up to a Memorial Hall was first raised. In 1965, an architectural design by Wang Dahung was chosen among many competitors and totally shown the Chinese traditional character of architecture. The main structure of the Memorial Hall was completed on May 16th, 1972.

The Memorial Hall was first under the administration of Taipei City Government. Later in July 1986, management of both the Memorial Hall and the Chungshan Hall were transferred to the Ministry of Education. And in 2012 we revamped under the Ministry of Culture. The main functions of Memorial Hall are to display historical documents concerning Dr. Sun, hold exhibitions and offer artistic performances. With many years expansion, we increase the multi-cultural hardware and software facilities. It plays an important role to promote social education, advance art activities and improve Sunology research in our society. It is expected that the Memorial Hall will catch up the paces of social development, and become most modern and full happiness culture palace.

The achievement displays of our life-long classes and related exhibitions are often held here.



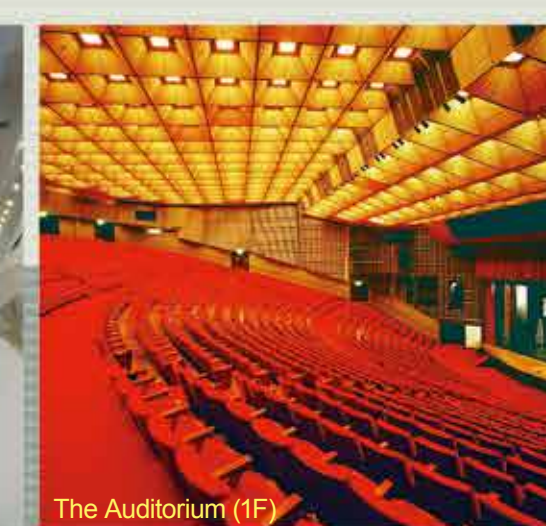
