





Everyday Contract Tips for Consumers (Part Three)

Consumers are often required to sign contracts for various consumer activities in the course of everyday life, from applying for a cell phone number, credit card, or insurance to purchasing high-priced items such as cars and real estate. It is therefore recommended that after signing a contract, you should keep a copy of the contract, receipts, promotional advertisements, and other documents. In addition, if there is a consumer dispute, an invoice is an important proof of return, exchange, or claim for compensation, and an e-invoice can be used to check the transaction records through the integrated service platform to get the details, making it a useful tool for claiming compensation.


