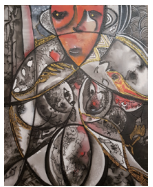

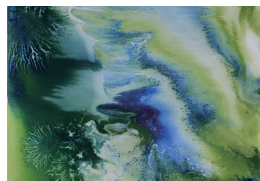

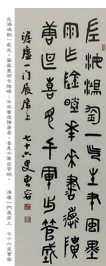


This exhibition showcases Wu Meiyun's innovative use of the long-established medium of oil painting, presenting a new style full of symbols of life and navigating the art of life.

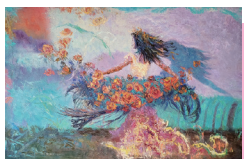
