## Journal of National Museum of History Submission Guidelines

- 1. Journal of National Museum of History (hereinafter referred to as this journal) is an international academic journal with the goal of promoting research and cultural exchanges. Topics of interests include historical and archeological artifacts both at home and abroad, modern works of calligraphy and ink painting, Taiwanese arts during the 30 years after World War II, museology and other disciplines related to historical artifacts. All academic papers and book reviews (the books published in the past 5 years) from scholars around the world that fit the above research fields and topics are welcome for submissions.
- 2. Submissions should, in principle, be research papers that have not been published elsewhere; please don't submit to more than one place. Please also remove any information from within the paper that can identify the author. If the paper has previously been published in another language or form, please indicate this and attach the original text.
- 3. This journal is published twice a year, in June and December.
- 4. The format of the manuscript must conform to the format of this journal. Unconfirmed manuscripts will not be accepted. Manuscripts are limited to Chinese and English. The guidance for Chinese Academic articles is to be within 8,000 to 20,000 characters. The guidance for English Academic articles is to be within 10,000 characters. The guidance for Chinese book reviews is to be within 5,000 to 10,000 characters. The guidance for Academic English book reviews is to be within 6,000 characters. Please attach an electronic copy, personal profile (name, current position, and academic background) and contact information.
- 5. The format for articles in English should be based on The Chicago Manual of Style on-line (17<sup>th</sup> edition): https://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools\_citationguide/citation-guide-2.html
- 6. The authors are responsible for the copyright matters and legal responsibilities of the content, drawings, tables, and citations of the manuscript.
- 7. All manuscripts are submitted to the review committee for review. After an article is accepted, the author will be notified separately. The remuneration for Chinese is NT \$1.2 per word for up to 20,000 words, and NT \$350 per drawing for up to 10 drawings.
- 8. Once a manuscript is accepted for publication, the author will be presented with 2 copies of this journal and an electronic offprint.
- 9. All listed authors of a submitted manuscript must agree that once it is published by this journal, they also authorize us to publish the article electronically on the website of the museum

(www.nmh.gov.tw) for public retrieval, browsing, downloading, transmitting, printing, etc. If the manuscript is to be republished elsewhere, it should be marked with a note indicating that it was already published in this journal.

10. This journal maintains the rights to edit a submitted manuscript. If you do not agree, please indicate in the manuscript. A manuscript will not be returned regardless of its acceptance for publication. If you need the manuscript to be returned, please also indicate in the manuscript.
